TUITION

Tuition is paid by all students according to the type of courses, the student's residency and total credits for which they enroll in a semester. Tuition is used to support the instructional and academic support costs of the college.

GENERAL FEE

The general fee is a required fee for all full and part-time students. Students pay according to the total number of credits for which they enroll in a semester. This fee is used to support processing a student's registration, including admissions, financial aid, testing, enrollment, advising, and bursar's services.

ACTIVITY FEE

This is a required fee for all full and part-time students. Students pay according to the total number of credits for which they enroll in a semester. This fee funds student government, clubs, and activities.

FACILITIES FEE

This is a required fee for all full and part-time students. Students pay according to the total number of credits for which they enroll in a semester. This fee supports deferred maintenance and renewal and replacement of facilities on all campuses.

CAMPUS SAFETY FEE

This is a required fee for all full and part-time students for each semester for which they enroll. This fee helps offset the costs of measures that protect the safety of the college community.

REGISTRATION FEE

This is a required fee for all full and part-time students for each semester for which they enroll. This fee helps offset the annual costs of the college's ERP system.

ONLINE COURSE FEE

This is a course fee charged to online and remote course sections. In addition to defraying the costs of instructional technology and instructional software, this fee is used towards building and improving our technology infrastructure.

HONOR LOCK FEE

This is a required fee for all students per academic year. This fee covers the annual cost associated with proctoring services.
